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### **Survey Background**

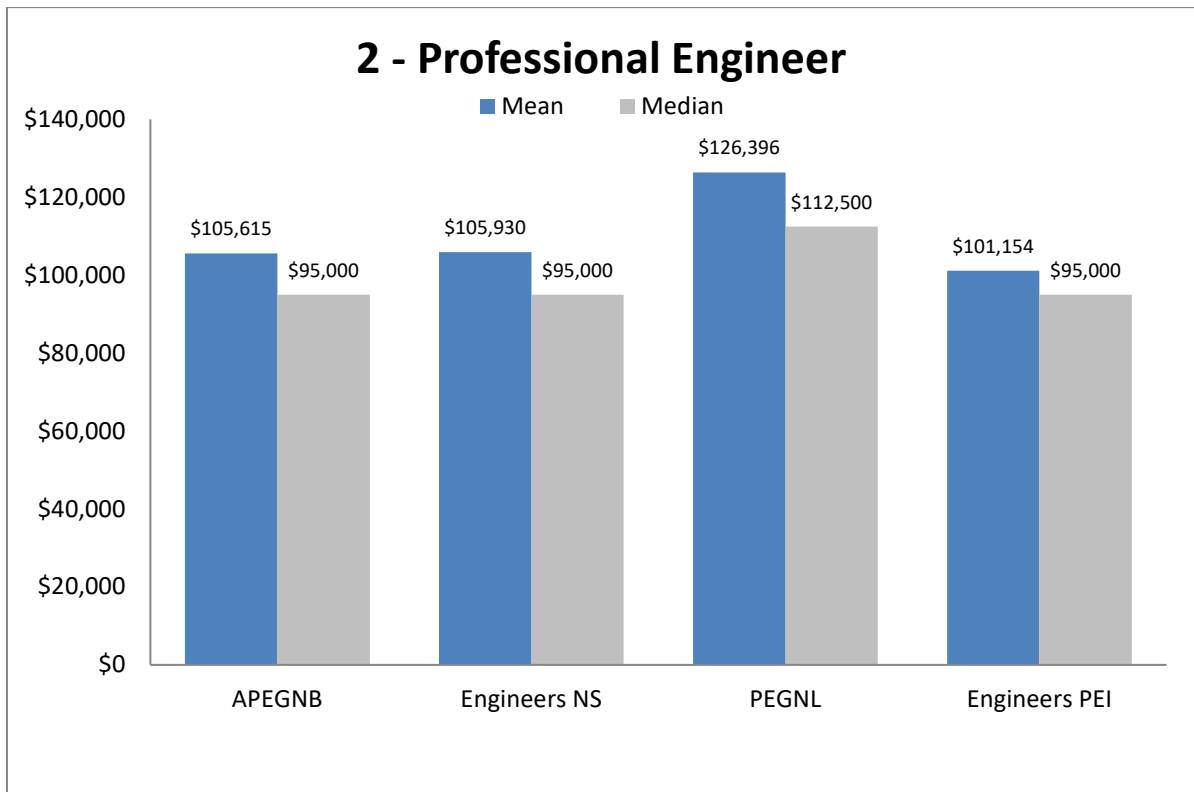
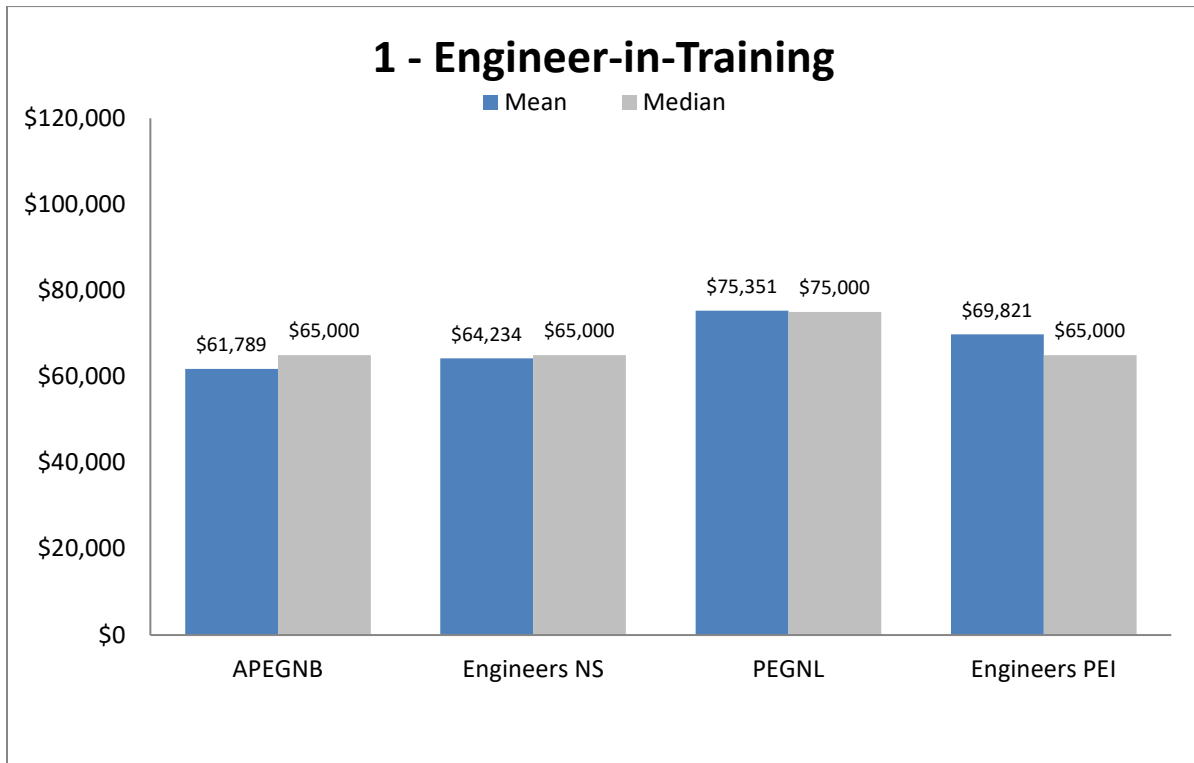
This year the Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland and Labrador (PEGNL), Engineers Nova Scotia, the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of New Brunswick (APEGNB), and Engineers PEI agreed to jointly complete an engineering salary and benefits survey. Many members, employers, and those considering a career in engineering have expressed an interest in obtaining current statistics on engineering salaries in the Atlantic region. It has been three years since members were asked to participate in the last survey.

The 2021 salary and benefits survey was conducted and compiled by ClearPicture Corp. The survey ran from the 20<sup>th</sup> of June until the 24<sup>th</sup> of September. This year 11,662 members were asked to participate in the survey, with 3562 responding for an overall participation rate of 31%. By association, responses rates were 29% for APEGNB, 34% for Engineers NS, 23% for PEGNL, and 45% for Engineers PEI. The margin of error (MOE) for the survey overall was 1.5%. By association, the MOE was 2.8% for APEGNB, 2.2% for Engineers NS, 3.3% for PEGNL, and 6.4% for Engineers PEI.

Only the aggregated data has been presented in this report. Individual members data will be kept confidential, and ClearPicture Corp. will not share that data with anyone. Data for groups under 5 has been suppressed within the report, but is still included in the aggregate data.

The mean, median, lower, and upper quartiles were calculated using the midpoint of each of the salary ranges. Where the mean is the average, median is the 50th percentile, lower quartile is the 25th percentile and the upper quartile is the 75th percentile.

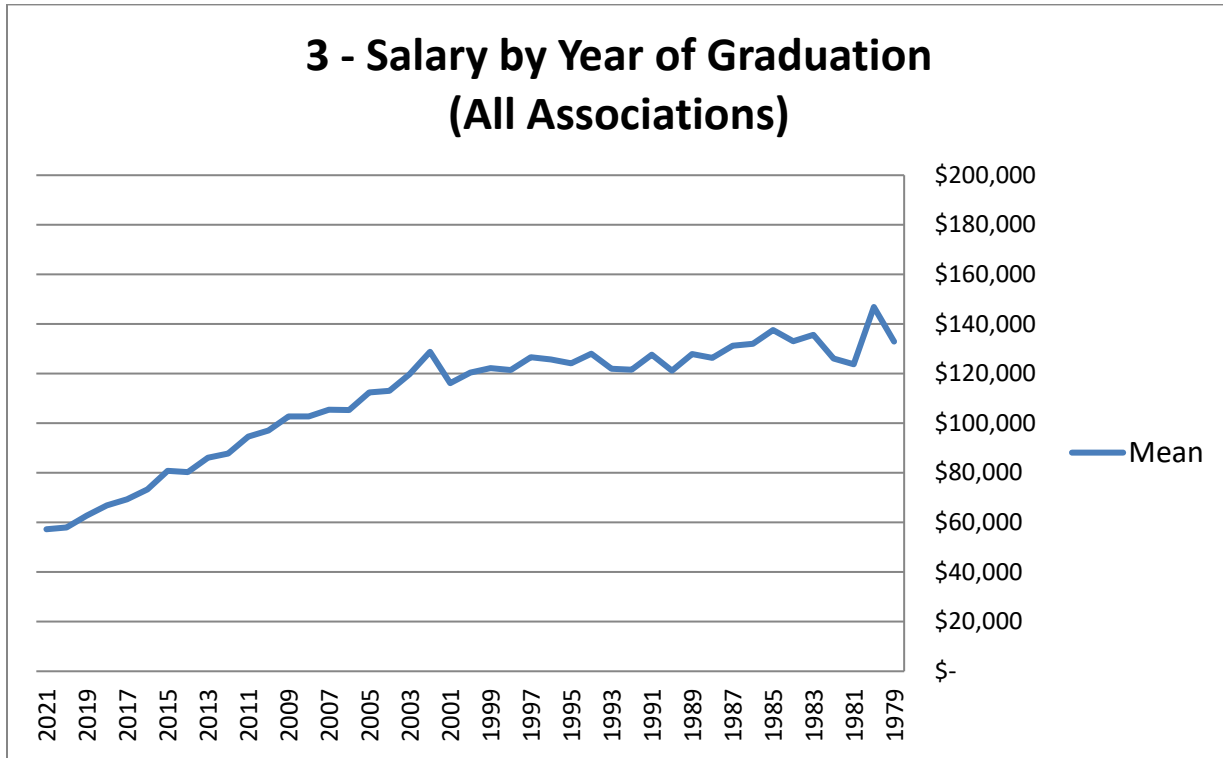
***Salary by Membership Status***

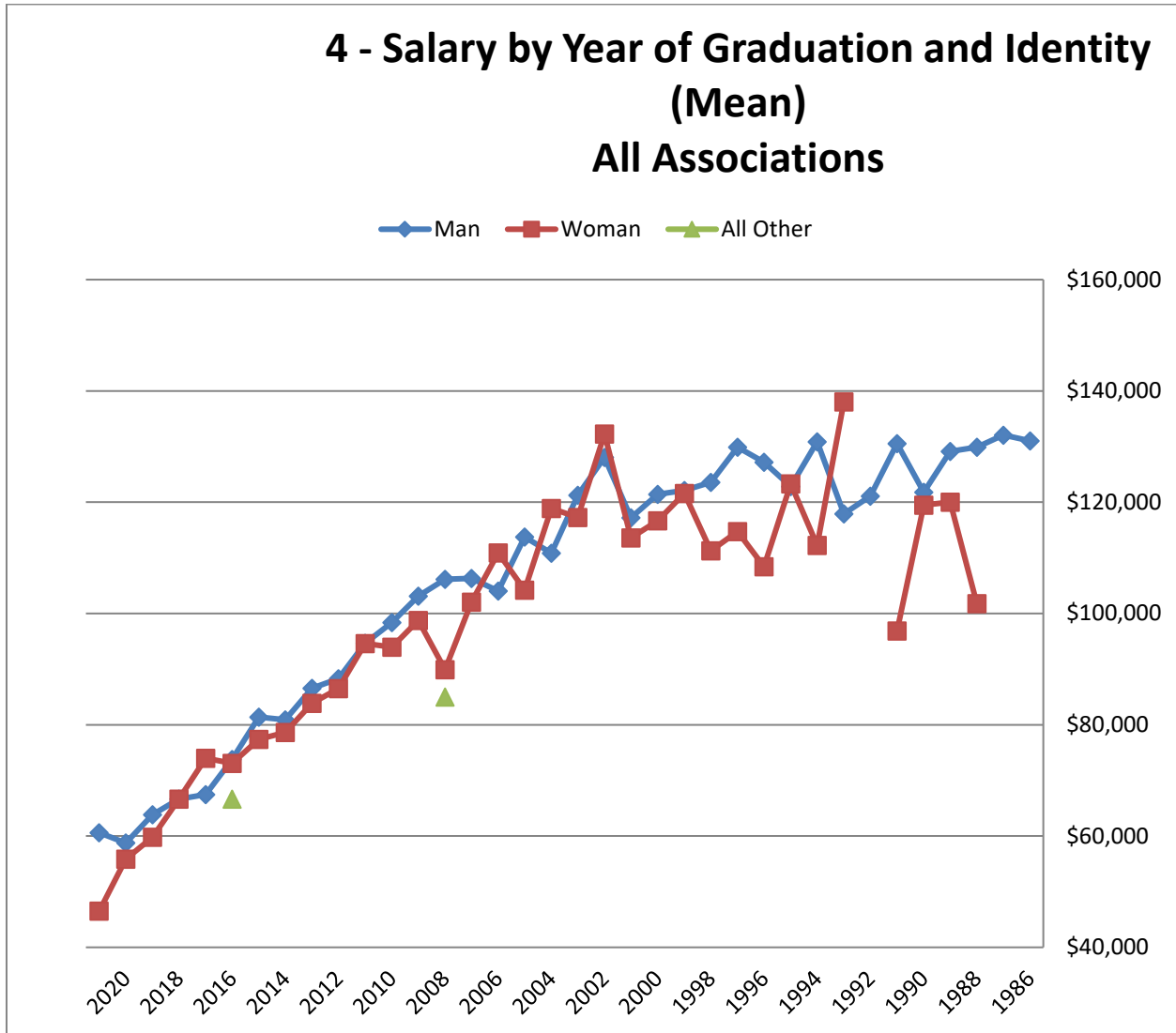

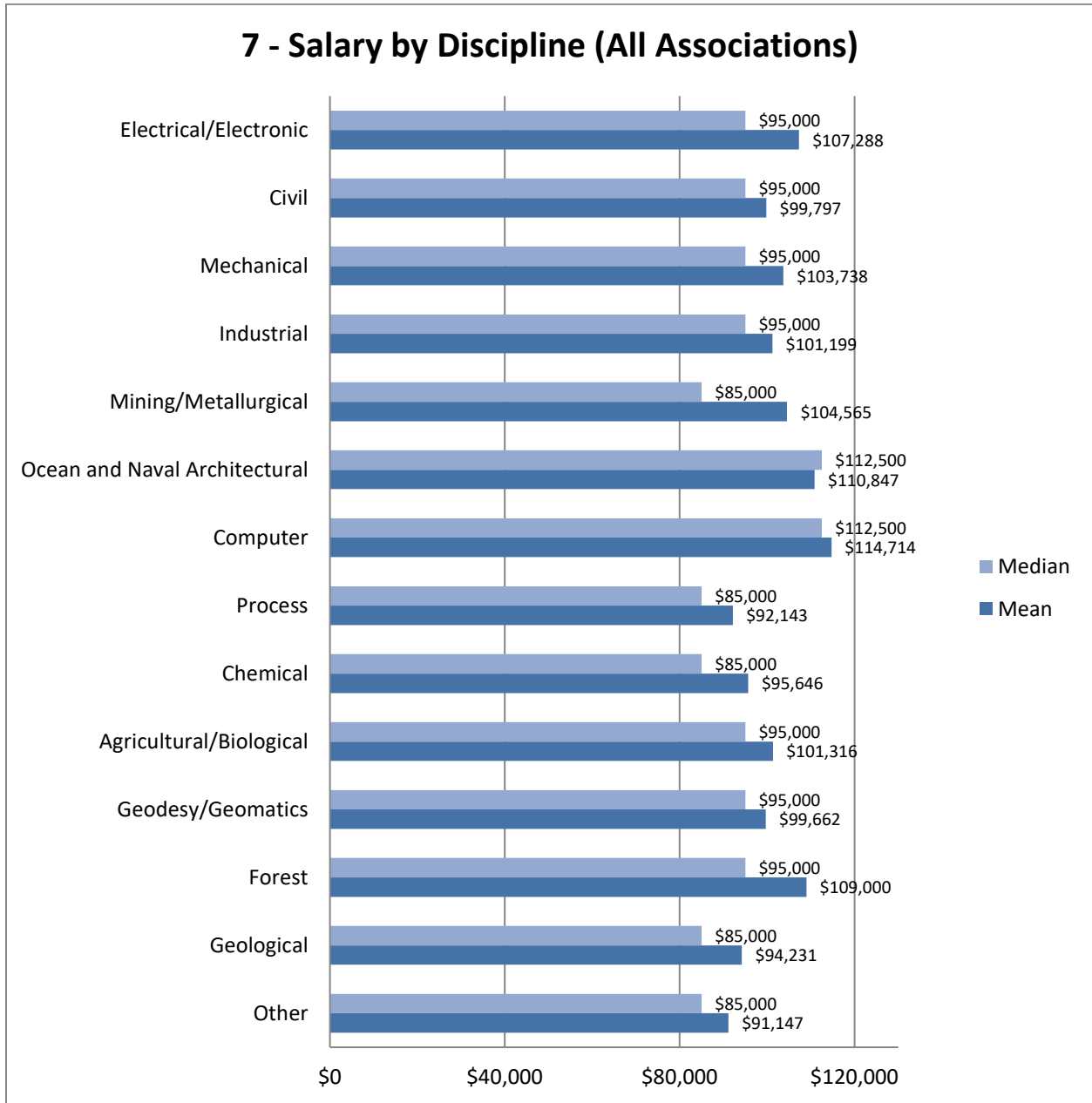


**Salary by Post-Graduate Degree**

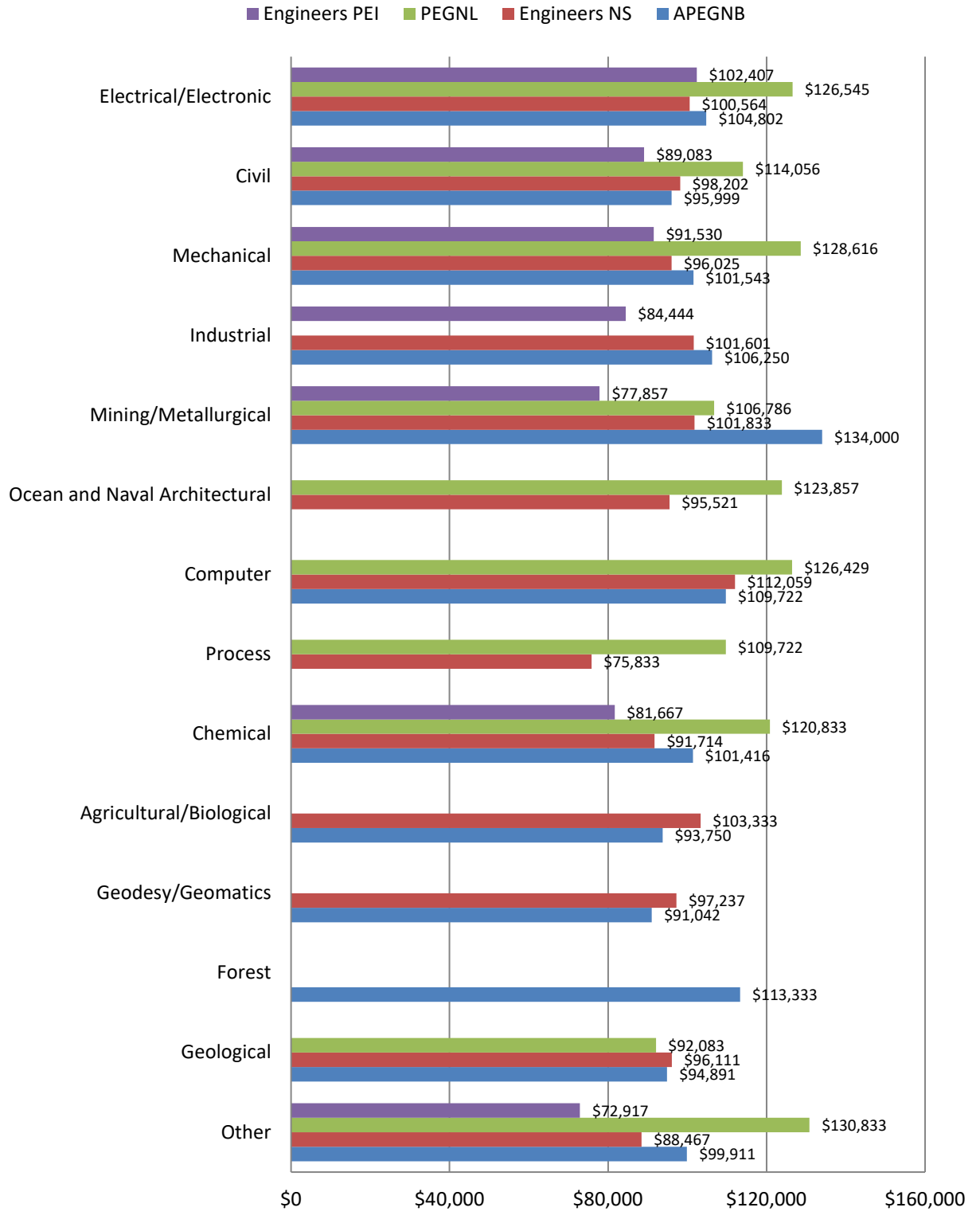

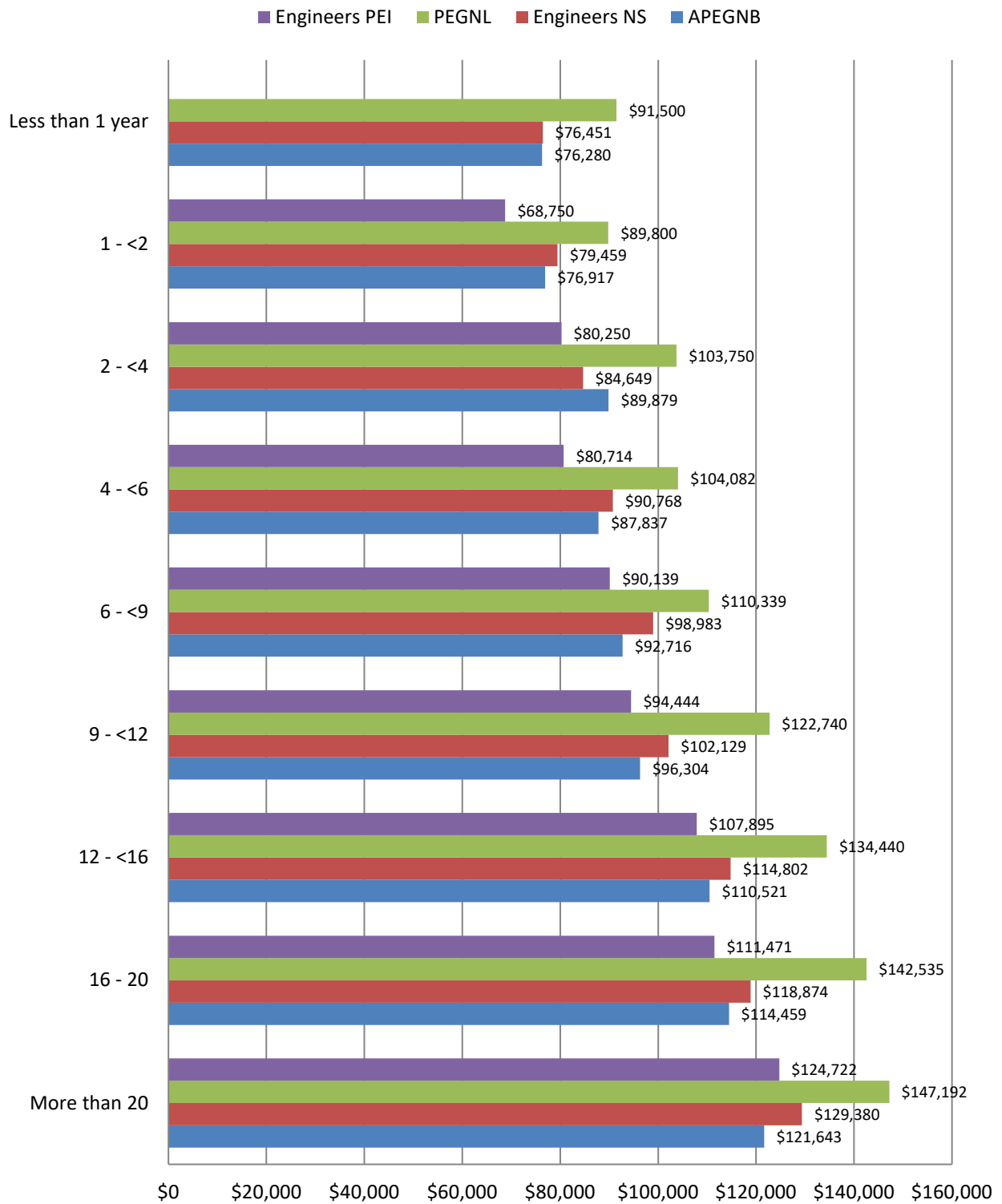

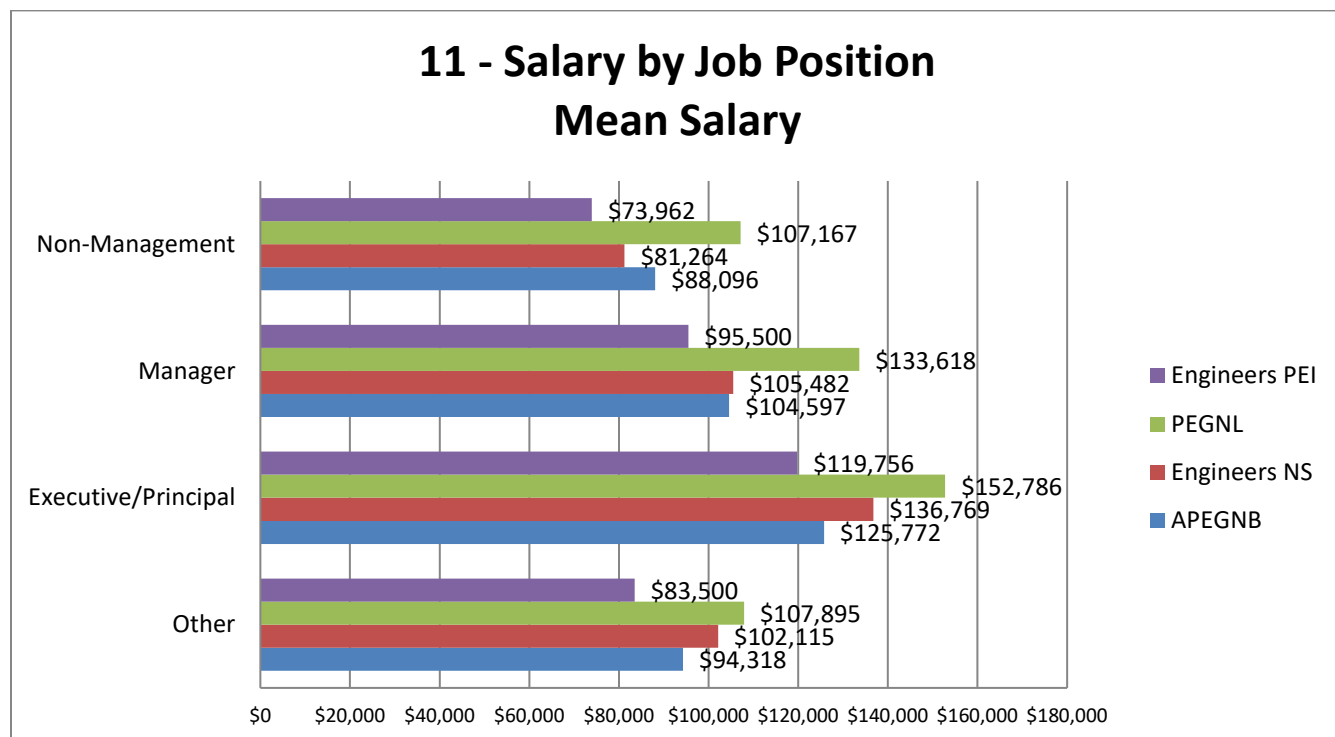
**Engineers-in-Training Salary by Years of Experience since Registration**

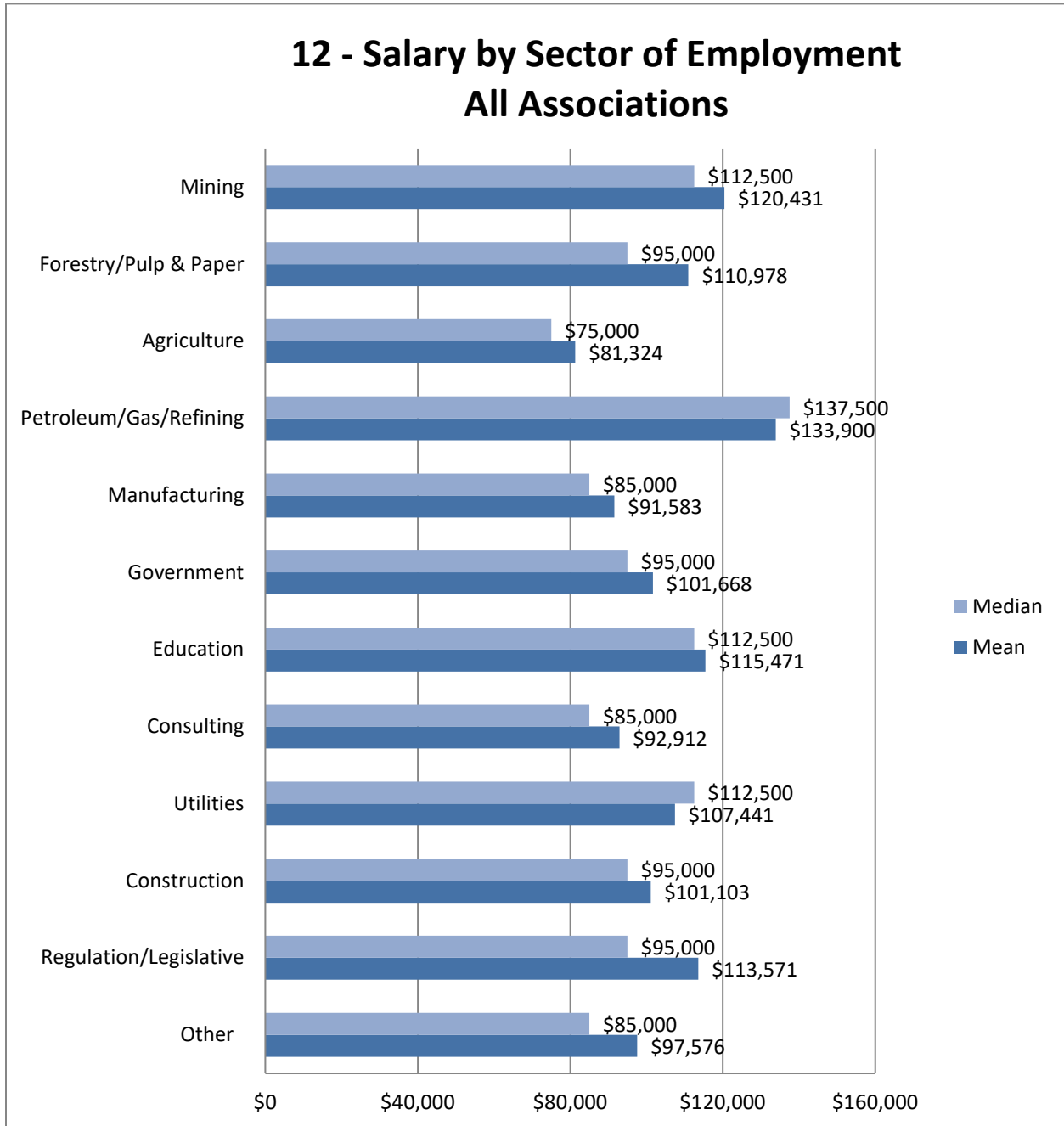

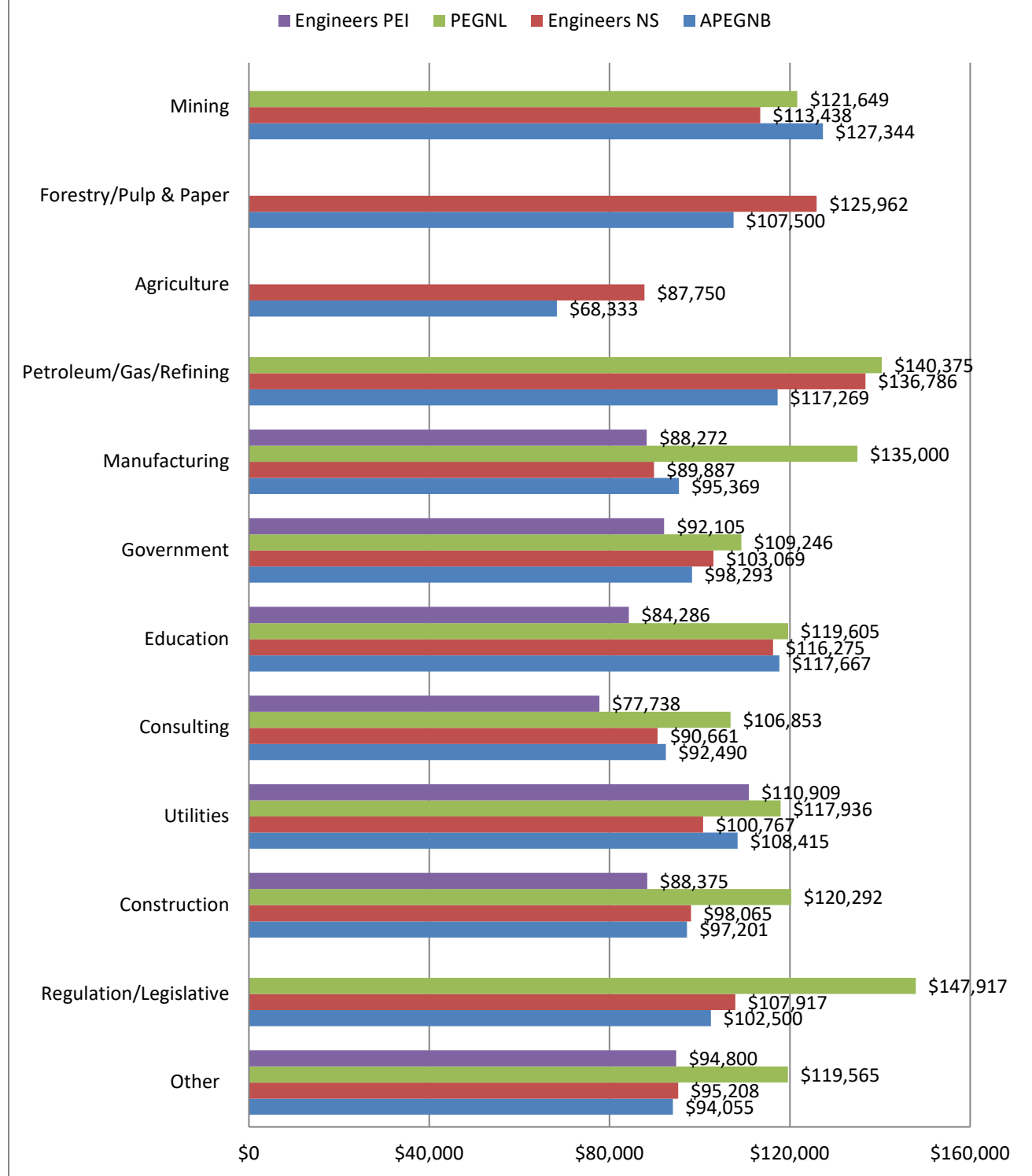

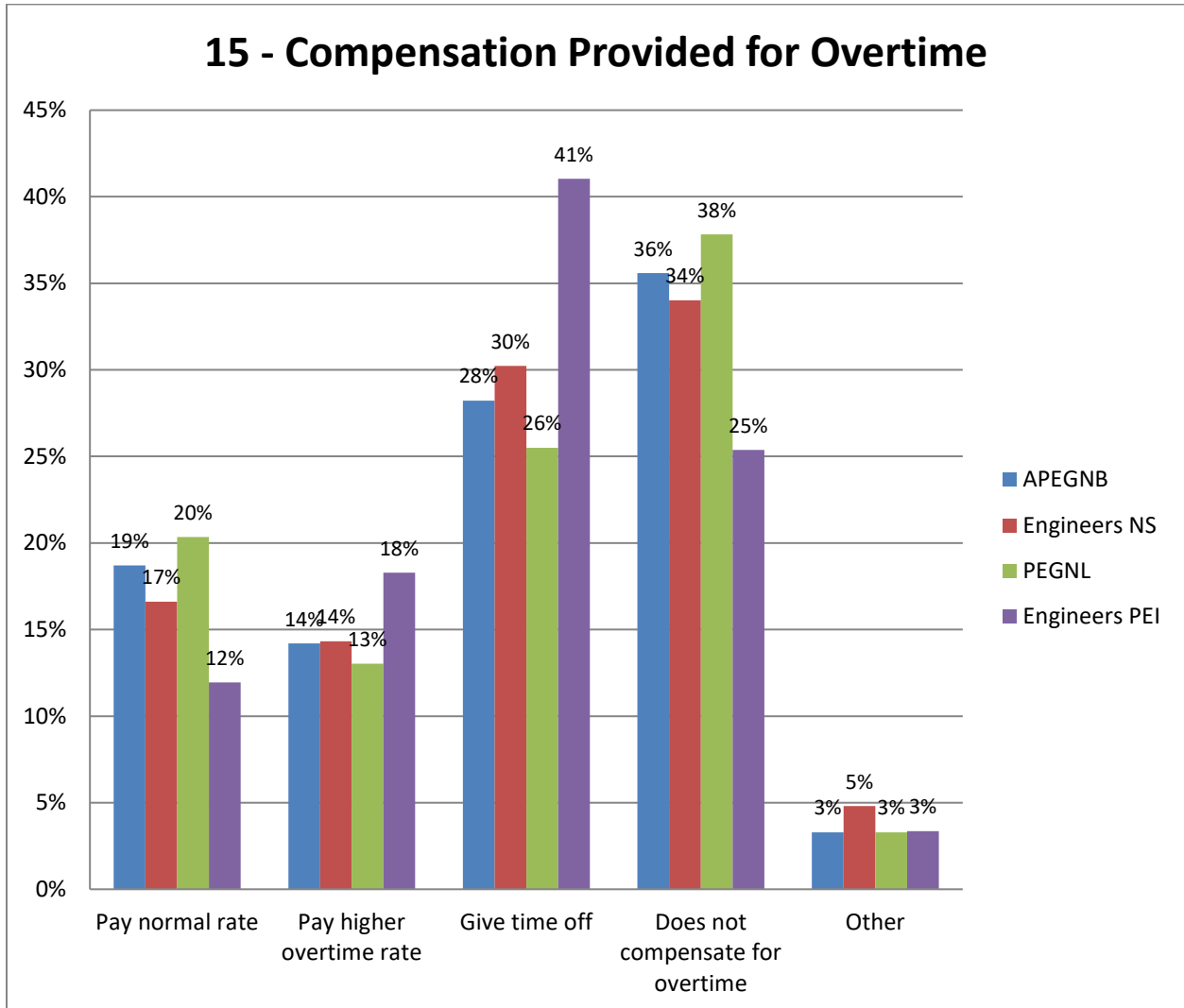
